

INTELLIGENT ROBOTS IN THE WORKPLACE WITHIN FIVE YEARS

A survey by Comtrade Digital Services, the leading software engineering services and solutions provider, found that 56 per cent of Irish IT decision-makers believe intelligent robots will be in the workplace within the next five years. The independent survey of 133 Irish IT leaders also found that 50 per cent of respondents expect driverless cars to make their way to Ireland by 2022.

The survey shows that Irish tech experts believe digital transformation is taking hold of Irish enterprises and affecting society. It found a strong vote of confidence in the continued growth of the internet of things in Ireland, with 74 per cent of respondents foreseeing smart fridges capable of ordering groceries being available by 2022. Other future technologies that IT professionals believe will be available in Ireland by 2022 include drone deliveries (63 per cent), intelligent robots in the home (38 per cent) and 3D printed foods (16 per cent).
